### ***Program Key Points***

#### ***1. Participants***

The program is open to any student studying in New Zealand between the age of 13 and 18 years. A limited number of spaces are available for accompanying adult chaperones.

#### ***2. Meet in Auckland***

Participants will meet at Auckland Airport at 6pm. Enjoy dinner together with pre-departure orientation. (A pre-departure orientation will be held in the upstairs restaurant area) Participants are required to make their own way there.

#### ***3. Departure***

The group will check in and depart on flight NZ97 at 1159 pm Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> December 2010.

#### ***4. Arrival***

5. The group will be met by Labo staff at Kansai International Airport and escorted into Osaka city. As part of the orientation with Labo students will stay the night in Osaka city. The following day participants will make their way to their respective homestay locations.

#### ***6. The Homestay***

18 nights homestay with a Labo host family. During the homestay 3 nights are spent at the popular Labo Camp. There is the possibility of a few days at your host's school. All Labo host families have children in the home and Labo will do its best to match a family with a similar age child and gender as you.

#### ***7. Labo Camp***

One of the highlights of the program is spending 3 nights with other Labo members at one of the Labo camps.

#### ***8. Labo Parties***

Your host will be a member of a Labo Party that they attend once per week. You will be welcomed and encouraged to join in with the Labo Party activities. The Labo Tutor who heads their particular Labo party will be a familiar face for you on the program and will also be a big part of the Labo support network.

#### ***9. Departure***

10. The group will depart their respective host homes and meet in Osaka for the journey to Kansai International Airport for an overnight flight back to Auckland.

#### ***11. Arrival***

The group arrives back on flight NZ98 at 5:25am on Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> January 2011. Transport back to your home will be your own responsibility.

#### ***12. Handling and Support***

The program is being handled by the Labo Exchange Foundation in Japan and Let's Homestay, Tauranga New Zealand. The group will fly Air New Zealand to Japan. Labo area staff and local tutors are in regular contact with participants as the local support network.
